Outside visits have been implemented for the nursing home. Bigfork Valley will be participating in the NW Health Services Coalition's region-wide surge test evacuation drill today, July 7.

Aaron reviewed Wilderness Health's summary of activities for May – June, 2020.

Aaron received the official document from Saint Scholastica for completing his MBA degree.
