A. Finance Committee Report

The Finance Committee meeting was held on Friday, July 22.

B. Financials

C. Accounts Payable

A <u>motion</u> to ratify the accounts payable for the month of June was made by the Finance Committee, seconded by Gordon Rahier. The motion passed unanimously.

D. <u>2023 Tax Levy</u>

The Finance Committee made a <u>motion</u> to set the final 2023 tax levy at \$836,220, an 8.6% increase from last year's levy (\$770,000). Seconded by Tom LaMont.

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This will be the final property tax levy for 2023.

Aaron reported that Bigfork Valley was accepted for a transitional care swing bed grant program through the Minnesota Department of Health. The flood insurance that was required for refinancing the bonds has been cancelled. The Villa roof project is done, and the siding is getting stained. There is new main entrance and ER signage. The nursing home survey resulted in only a few minor tags.
